Call to order at 1:04 P.M.

It was moved Trustee Miles; seconded Trustee Gregory: That the agenda be adopted. Carried.

It was moved Trustee Miles that Trustee Gregory be nominated as Chairperson. Carried

The adoption of the minutes for August 2nd, 2015 and March 2nd, 2016 were moved Trustee Miles and seconded Trustee Gregory and approved.

The Task list was reviewed and updated. Trustee Miles reported on the progress regarding the new generator building and installation of the generator into the operating system. New plugs are needed in the pumphouse. Trustee Gregory will contact the Trustee Delegate and the Administrator to update that section of the Task List.

- b. Trustee Miles reported on the major water loss on a lot on Brian's Way and will investigate further and report to the next meeting.
- c. Annual Reporting Requirements of the Ministry were discussed.
- d. The RBC Bank issue was discussed. Trustee Miles reported that it took the bank 10 days to find the mistake and that SSID did not receive an apology for creating the problem and sent a form letter instead.
- e. Recommendation from the Auditor regarding a single Capital Reserve Fund Account It was moved Trustee Gregory; seconded Trustee Miles: That Trustee Miles investigate the establishment of a single account for the Capital reserve Fund and report back to the trustees. Carried.
- f. Trustee Miles reported on the logistic nightmare involved in getting insurance and permission to operate the new Utility Cart which has been purchased to replace the truck provided by the Trustee Delegate.
